Admission dates

Admission ceremonies								
In Sydney, admission ceremonies will be held on:								
23 February	21 June	18 October						
22 March	19 July	15 November						
12 April	16 August	13 December						
24 May	13 September							
In Newcastle: an admission ceremony will be held on one day only, on 9 February 2024*.								
* Applicants who want to be admitted in Newcastle must lodge their applications by 12 December 2023 (or by 10 October 2023 if they have a complex admission application).								

Deadlines for lodging applications

The application deadlines are:

- for simple admission applications (ie applications with no disclosure or a non-significant disclosure)
 o lodge your application at least 5 weeks prior to the ceremony date of your choice
- for complex admission applications (ie applications with a significant disclosure or seeking dispensation from a requirement of the Uniform Admission Rules)
 - o note that complex admission applications can only be determined at a Board meeting
 - o refer to the table below for the application deadline that applies to each Board meeting.

Booking a ceremony

You can book a ceremony after we have confirmed receipt of all your documentary evidence.

• To book an **admission ceremony**, login to the online Admission Portal to book the available date and time of your choice. Ceremony bookings are subject to availability, as spaces are limited.

Please note that:

- if your application has not been approved by one week before your admission date, your booking will be automatically cancelled.
- If you have a complex application and you need to travel inter-city or from overseas to attend your ceremony, we recommend you do not book a ceremony until your application has been approved by the Board.
