DISTINCTION  15 - 17	<ul> <li>Demonstrates work of superior quality and a thorough knowledge of the subject and relevant laws</li> <li>Can identify and solve legal problems with intellectual independence, critical review and creative thinking</li> <li>Skillfully manipulates the legal knowledge to present a logical and persuasive argument, with an analytical and conceptual ability of higher order critical thinking</li> <li>Supports the answers with relevant authority, often evidenced by extensive research, preparation and ability to distinguish between high and low level quality sources</li> <li>Structures the response in a clear and organised way; logically arrives at a well-considered conclusion</li> <li>Expression is clear, grammatically correct and in line with the required conventions of legal writing</li> <li>Uses legal terminology appropriately</li> <li>Where relevant, demonstrates high-level problemsolving skills by applying the law to the facts in an efficient way</li> <li>Where relevant, demonstrates lateral thinking by considering alternative arguments and solutions, and makes a reasoned choice amongst them</li> </ul>

13 - 14	<ul> <li>Presents a coherent argument by manipulating the knowledge efficiently, with some ability to analyse more complex legal issues</li> <li>Supports the answers with adequate authority, although at times may not include the most relevant sources</li> <li>Structures the response in a clear way and has a sound grasp of relevant skills</li> <li>Expression is coherent and in line with the required conventions of legal writing</li> <li>Attempts to use legal terminology with some success</li> <li>Where relevant, demonstrates problem-solving skills by applying the law to the facts in an adequate way</li> <li>Where relevant, attempts to consider alternative arguments and solutions</li> </ul>	65 - 74
PASS	<ul> <li>Demonstrates a satisfactory knowledge of the subject and relevant laws</li> </ul>	PASS
10 - 12	<ul> <li>Provides acceptable arguments and justifications without much persuasive ability</li> <li>Manipulation of legal knowledge into a coherent response may be inefficient, purely descriptive or lacking depth of comprehension and analysis</li> <li>Attempts to structure the response but at times the response may be circular, repetitive or irrelevant</li> <li>Attempts to select relevant authority to support the answers with some success</li> <li>Expression may be unclear, imprecise or colloquial, with some grammatical or stylistic errors</li> <li>No or confused use of legal terminology</li> <li>Where relevant, attempts to use problem-solving skills</li> <li>Where relevant, may consider alternative arguments</li> </ul>	50 - 64

8 - 9	<ul> <li>Demonstrates insufficient or faulty understanding of subject and deficiencies in understanding of fundamental concepts</li> <li>Lacks basic skills to manipulate knowledge and apply it in the new context</li> <li>Arguments are undeveloped or unsupported</li> <li>Does not identify key points in the question and provides a response that may be irrelevant</li> <li>Relies on large quotations with little evidence of independent legal reasoning</li> <li>The response is mainly descriptive with little, if any, evidence of individual analysis or evaluation</li> <li>Poor expression, little attention to conventions of legal writing</li> <li>No or inadequate use of legal terminology</li> <li>Work may be incomplete or well below the word limit</li> </ul>	49 or fewer
SERIOUS FAIL 7 or fewer	<ul> <li>As for Fail, and/or</li> <li>Academic misconduct or plagiarism</li> <li>Gross ignorance of elementary rules or principles</li> <li>Does not apply legal reasoning</li> <li>Does not answer the question, content is incomprehensible, irrelevant or off topic</li> <li>Expression is inadequate, incoherent or substandard in terms of grammar or spelling conventions</li> <li>Not a serious attempt</li> </ul>
